GUIDELINES FOR LETTER JACKETS AND SWEATERS

The following rules are to help Farmington High School students chose the style and decoration of their varsity jacket sweaters. These rules are updated periodically by a student committee. The purpose is to establish consistency in the color, style and especially the decoration of the official school jacket. We all take pride in being a part of Farmington High School and hope you will demonstrate your spirit, loyalty and cohesiveness by maintaining our school symbols in accordance with these guidelines.

The lacket

Navy blue with white leather sleeves. Matching navy blue knitted shoulder insert, cuffs and collar.

The Sweater

Navy blue V-neck, crew neck, pullover or cardigan

The Service Bar or Chevron

The service bar is a gold pin worn on the letter F. The chevron shall be 5/8" wide and worn on the left sleeve. The student may wear a second, third or fourth bar or chevron when he or she letters in a different sport or in the same sport of activity a second, third or fourth time.

The Letter

The letter must be the 6" school issued chenille letter, sewn on the left front side of either the jacket or sweater. There are six kinds of letters awarded – athletic letters are plain white. Band, color guard, debate, forensics and academic letters are decorated with words or symbols. Only one letter is worn at a time, the student may choose which one he or she wants to display. Purchasing pins to wear on the letter may indicate other varsity activities. Only one sports letter is awarded for all sports. Once a sports letter has been earned, the student receives a service bar each time he or she letters in the same sport.

FRONT DECORATION

<u>Name</u>

Your name may be placed, in small stitch, on the upper right front.

<u>Patches</u> — Only patches indicate city, league, district, regional, or state championship and All-American teams are worn. Only one championship patch per sport or activity should be worn, either the most recent or the highest honor. They are sewn on the right front side only, not on the back or down the sleeves.

<u>Pins</u> – Varsity Club, graduation year pins, service bars and pins pertaining to sports participation are worn only on the letter F

<u>Medals</u> – team or individual medals won in league, district, regional, state championships or All-American teams are worn only on the letter F.

Graduation Year Patch - The year of graduation is worn on the left shoulder of the jacket or sweater.

<u>Captain's Stars</u> - Only captains of a varsity squad or section leaders may have a star on their jackets. Only one star to represent all sports and activities may be placed on the right shoulder.

BACK DECORATIONS

Every jacket should include the words Farmington Falcons, Farmington, or Falcons in navy and white script. The names of a sport or activity of the word varsity may also be embroidered on the back. Student's names are discouraged. Any decorative patches or emblems should illustrate the sport or activity or reflect school spirit. It is expected that the student has earned a varsity letter in the sport of activity displayed on the back.
